We are happy to announce that Nari-O-Shishu Kalyan Kendra has been awarded Best Organisation for Gender Equality by Martha Farrell Foundation.



We are humbled by the recognition given to our work of over four decades. Nari-O-Sishu Kalyan Kendra started its journey from setting up a library in a village in West Bengal, but soon realised that the gender inequality was deep rooted in the society which hindered girls from accessing education and freedom of movement even to their local library. This led to targeted interventions over the next decade where women collectivised to discuss

how gender-based violence was impacting their lives. This led to a lot of back lashes from the community, but the organisation and its leaders persisted on and led mobilisation of women through livelihood, child welfare and educational intervention.

Today Nari-O-Sishu Kalyan Kendra is well integrated into the fabric of the community and is seen as a source of support to women and girls facing gender-based violence. Over the last three decades Nari-O-Sishu Kalyan Kendra has expanded from Howrah district to the Kolkata, Murshidabad, Birbhum, Dinajpur, Nadia, South 24 Parganas districts of West Bengal as well as Jharkhand.
